Structural Firefighter Training

Standard Operating Guideline (SOG)

Adopted: 9/18/2013, Filed: 11/19/2013; Jim Noel, Chair

Purpose: The purpose of this SOG is to outline and set the minimum training requirements for all firefighters in Albany County Fire District 1 (ACFD1) actively engaged in offensive and defensive structure firefighting operations on the fireground. This SOG will also set the minimum training standards for structure firefighting operations on the fire ground in a support role.

- I. All standards set forth will be in compliance with National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) 1001: Standard for Firefighter Professional Qualifications.
- II. All standards are available through the Wyoming State Fire Marshal's Office website.
 - a. Training Record-In-house Comprehensive Exam
 - i. All skills must be tested and signed off by the department Training Officer or Chief/Authority Having Jurisdiction (AHJ). The personnel designated to test and sign off on practicals will have completed and been signed off by AHJ on the NFPA 1001 skills they are training and testing their firefighter on.

- III. Training requirements for structural firefighting will be applicable to all firefighters employed as volunteer firefighters by ACFD1 departments who will be participating in active structure firefighting operations.
 - a. All firefighters will, at a minimum, meet the following standards in order to participate in structural firefighting operations. (Note: This excludes firefighters who participate in water tender only operations)
 - i. Hose and Nozzle Training
 - ii. Safety Training
 - iii. Ladder Training
 - iv. SCBA Training
 - v. PPE Training
 - vi. ICS Training (Minimum ICS 100 200 and NIMS 700)
 - b. All firefighters who wish to participate in interior attack firefighting operations will be certified to the Pro Board or State FF1 Training Level

per NFPA 1001 and Wyoming State Fire Marshal's Office guidelines (see section II).

- c. All firefighters who participate in water tender only/support role operations will meet the minimum requirements as follows.
 - i. Hose and Nozzle Training
 - ii. Safety Training
 - iii. Water Supply
 - iv. PPE Training
 - v. ICS Training (Minimum ICS 100 200 and NIMS 700)
